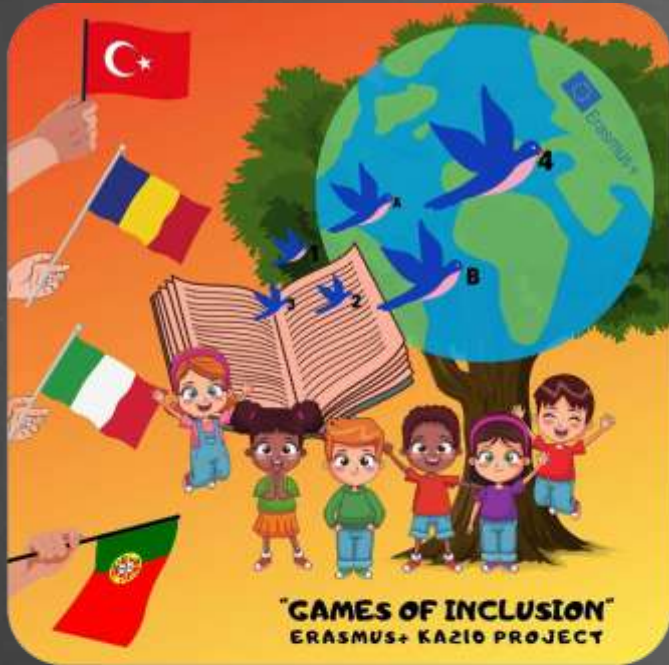

In the morning, we start the day with sports and physical activity. We both wake up and get our energy and get motivated for the day.

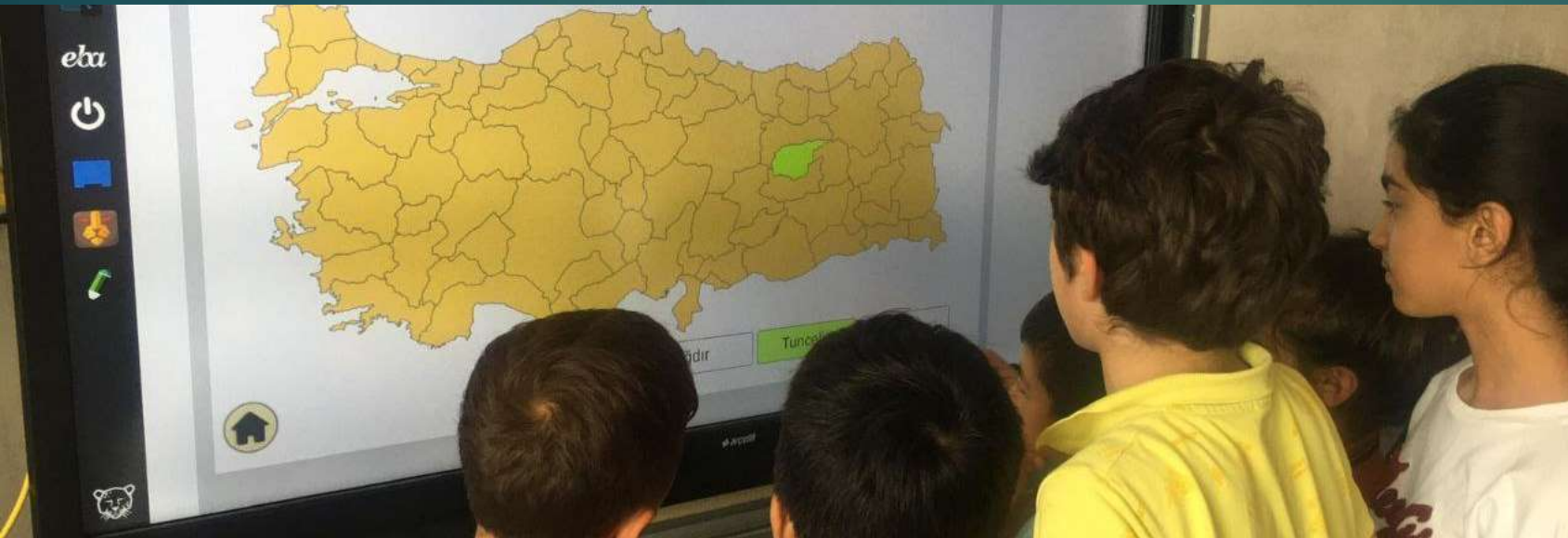
A proverb says: «A healthy mind in a healthy body!»
